The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received from the United States Department of Energy (DOE), Triad National Security, LLC, and Newport News Nuclear BWXT-Los Alamos, LLC (N3B) (collectively, the Permittees) a *Class 1 Permit Modification Request Requiring Prior Approval to Add Solid Waste Management Unit 02-014 to the Los Alamos National Laboratory Hazardous Waste Facility Permit* (PMR), referenced by EM2018-0042. The Permittees submitted the PMR on October 11, 2018, seeking to modify the Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) Hazardous Waste Facility Permit (Permit) Table K-1 of Attachment K, "Listing of SWMUs and AOCs", to add a newly discovered solid waste management unit (SWMU) within Technical Area 02 (TA-02). The newly discovered SWMU, consisting of three former electrical transformer stations that served buildings at TA-02, shall be added to the Permit as SWMU 02-014.


