Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) (EPA ID NM0890010515) operates under a Hazardous Waste Facility Permit (the Permit) issued by the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) to the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) National Nuclear Security Administration Los Alamos Field Office (NA-LA); the DOE Environmental Management Los Alamos Field Office (EM-LA); Triad National Security, LLC; and Newport News Nuclear BWXT-Los Alamos, LLC (N3B) (the Permittees). The purpose of this letter is to report EM-LA/N3B's hazardous waste treatability studies for calendar year (CY) 2019 to NMED's Hazardous Waste Bureau (HWB).

Reporting of hazardous waste treatability studies conducted during the previous calendar year is required annually for all hazardous waste generators in the State of New Mexico by Title 20, Chapter 4, Part 1, Section 200 of the New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC), as revised March 1, 2009 [incorporating Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations [40 CFR] 261.4(f)(9)].

N3B/EM-LA did not conduct any hazardous waste treatability studies at LANL during CY 2019. For proposed hazardous waste treatability studies, a notice of intent to conduct a study will be prepared and submitted to NMED-HWB at least 45 days before beginning the study, as required by 20.4.1.200 NMAC [40 CFR 261.4(f)(9)].
