The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the United States Department of Energy's (DOE's) *Field Completion Letter Report for Aggregate Area Known Cleanup Sites Campaign: SWMU 39-002(a), SWMU 46-004(q), SWMU 15-008(b), and SWMU 15-007(c)* (Report), dated and received on November 14, 2019 and referenced by EMLA-2020-1097-02-001.

The Report was submitted to fulfill the requirement of Known Cleanup Sites Campaign, Milestone #19 of Appendix B for fiscal year (FY) 2019 under the 2016 Compliance Order on Consent (CO). The original due date for submittal of the Report was September 30, 2019. However, on September 20, 2019 DOE requested an extension to November 15, 2019 for submittal of the Report. NMED approved the request on October 4, 2019.

The Report summarizes the completion of field work at SWMU 39-002(a), SWMU 46-004(q), SWMU 15-008(b), and SWMU 15-007(c) as required by FY 2019 Milestone #19. The results of investigations for SWMU 39-002(a) will be presented in the Phase II Investigation Report for North Ancho Canyon Aggregate Area; for SWMU 46-004(q) in the Phase II Investigation Report for Upper Cañada del Buey Aggregate Area; and for SWMU 15-008(b) and SWMU 15-007(c) in the Phase II Investigation Report for Threemile Canyon Aggregate Area.

NMED hereby validates that the letter report meets the requirement of FY 2019 Milestone # 19 of the CO. This validation does not constitute an approval of the field work conducted at the sites described in

the Report. The DOE will present analytical results and risk assessments in future investigation reports. NMED will conduct review of analytical data and risk evaluations at that time.
