Subject: Request for Extension of Time to Respond to Administratively Incomplete Determination for Part A and General Part B of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Permit Renewal Application

Dear Mr. Pierard:

The United States Department of Energy (DOE) and its field offices, the National Nuclear Security Administration Los Alamos Field Office (NA-LA), the DOE-Environmental Management Los Alamos Field Office (EM-LA), along with Triad National Security, LLC (Triad), and Newport News Nuclear BWXT-Los Alamos, LLC (N3B), collectively the Permittees, are submitting a request to the New Mexico Environment Department-Hazardous Waste Bureau (NMED-HWB) for an extension of time to respond to an Administratively Incomplete Determination letter received from the NMED-HWB on March 23, 2021. The letter presents comments regarding the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Permit Renewal Application submitted to the NMED-HWB on June 29, 2020 and requires a response by May 23, 2021.


The Permittees request a 60-day extension of time to respond to the March 23, 2021 letter. The extension is necessary to enable the Permittees to compile more information to provide a complete response to the NMED-HWB comments. If approved, the new deadline for the response will be July 22, 2021.

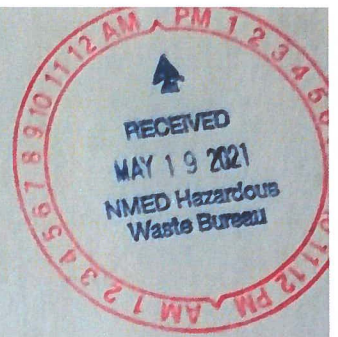
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
