**Subject: Request for Extension of Time to Respond to Second Administratively Incomplete Determination for Part A and General Part B of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act Permit Renewal Application**

Dear Mr. Shean:

The United States Department of Energy and its field offices, the National Nuclear Security Administration Los Alamos Field Office (NA-LA), and the Environmental Management - Los Alamos Field Office (EM-LA), in association with Triad National Security, LLC (Triad) and Newport News Nuclear BWXT- Los Alamos, LLC (N3B), collectively the Permittees, submit this request to the New Mexico Environment Department-Hazardous Waste Bureau (NMED-HWB) for an extension of time to respond to a Second Administratively Incomplete Determination letter dated January 25, 2022. The letter included determinations that require the Permittees to make changes and additions to the Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL), EPA ID#NM0890010515, Permit Renewal Application submitted to the NMED-HWB in June 2020.

Per the Facility Hazardous Waste Permit Section 1.9.19, *Extensions of Time*, the Permittees request a 60-day extension to respond to the January 25, 2022, letter. The extension will enable the Permittees to complete field activities for the facility seismic location analysis and to include information as discussed in a meeting with the NMED-HWB on February 17, 2022. If approved, the new deadline for the response will be May 25, 2022.
