Dear Karen Armijo and Lee Bishop:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the United States Department of Energy (DOE), the National Nuclear Security Administration Los Alamos Field Office (NA-LA) and the DOE - Environmental Management Los Alamos Field Office (EM-LA), along with Triad National Security, LLC (Triad), and Newport News Nuclear BWXT-Los Alamos, LLC (N3B) (collectively, the Permittees) *Demolition Notification for Quarter Ending June 30, 2022, Hazardous Waste Permit*, dated March 29, 2022, and received March 29, 2022, and referenced by EPC-DO-22-077/LA-UR-22-22143.

As stated by the Permittees, investigations are not complete at several Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) and Areas of Concern (AOCs) located within 50 feet of the buildings proposed for demolition. The Permittees state that they will ensure that the sampling locations and depths proposed in the approved work plans are not affected by these activities. In the case of adverse impacts to the SWMUs/AOCs where investigations are not complete, the Permittees must document all demolition activities that affect any SWMU or AOC in detail so that any impacts on work proposed at the SWMUs/AOCs can be identified and evaluated.

On April 25, 2022, NMED requested an additional figure for building 60-2138. The building was used for storage from 2000 to 2020 and NMED could not locate it in the databases. On April 29, 2022, NMED received the requested figure, along with an updated table with the correct

building number. The building was referenced as 60-2138 in the original table but was corrected to reflect its correct number of 03-2138. On May 10, 2022, NMED requested a confirmation of the number and location of Building 03-2138 at the current location. This was confirmed by DOE via email on May 13, 2022.

NMED has reviewed the document and has no further comments.

The Permittees must provide a copy of demolition reports, if prepared, to NMED within 30 days after the reports are complete in accordance with Permit Section 1.17.3.
