This letter is to acknowledge your letter of February 6, 2024 to revise Air Quality NSR Permit 2195 for U.S. Department of Energy National Nuclear Security Administration, Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL). This facility is located in the town of Los Alamos in Los Alamos County, New Mexico. This revision is pursuant to Title 20 of the New Mexico Administrative Code, Chapter 2 Part 72 (20.2.72 NMAC) Construction Permits Section 219.A. and Section 202.B. The request was received by the New Mexico Environment Department's Air Quality Bureau (Department) on February 6, 2024.

A review of the information you submitted confirms that the requirements specified in 20.2.72 NMAC, Construction Permits, Permit Revisions, Section 219.A and Section 202.B are met.

This administrative revision adds two gas-fired heaters (HeatStar, model HS125LP, and serial #sLN-170800-23001179 and LN-170800-23001040), rated less than five million BTU per hour (0.125 MMBtu/hr), use at Technical Area TA-54-0375, for personal use of heating buildings or water. The units shall meet the minor NSR exemption at 20.2.72.202.B.1(a) NMAC for fuel burning equipment and Title V Insignificant Activity number 3. As stated in the application letter, the emissions from these two heaters will be included in emission reporting for small boilers and is subject to emission limits in Table 802.A of the Title V Operating Permit P100-R2M5. 20.2.72 NMAC Section 219.A.3 specifies that administrative permit revisions under 202.B become effective upon receipt of the notification by the Department.

This letter, NSR 2195-R99, shall be attached to Air Quality Permit No. 2195 issued by the Department on June 16, 1999 to serve as acknowledgment by the Department that this administrative revision qualifies as an exemption.
