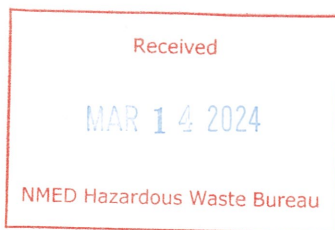

Subject: Hazardous Waste Treatability Study Report for Calendar Year 2023

Dear Mr. Shean:


Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) (EPA ID NM0890010515) operates under a Hazardous Waste Facility Permit (the Permit) issued by the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) to the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) National Nuclear Security Administration Los Alamos Field Office (NA-LA); the DOE Environmental Management Los Alamos Field Office (EM-LA); Triad National Security, LLC; and Newport News Nuclear BWXT-Los Alamos, LLC (N3B) (collectively, the Permittees). The purpose of this letter is to report the EM-LA/N3B hazardous waste treatability studies for calendar year (CY) 2023 to the NMED Hazardous Waste Bureau (HWB).

Reporting of hazardous waste treatability studies conducted during the previous calendar year is required of hazardous waste generators in the State of New Mexico by Title 20, Chapter 4, Part 1, Section 200 of the New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC), as revised December 1, 2018, incorporating Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations [40 CFR 261.4(f)(9)].

EM-LA/N3B did not conduct any hazardous waste treatability studies at LANL during CY 2023. For proposed hazardous waste treatability studies, EM-LA/N3B will prepare and submit to NMED-HWB a notice of intent to conduct a study at least 45 days before beginning the study, as required by 20.4.1.200 NMAC [40 CFR 261.4(f)(9)].
