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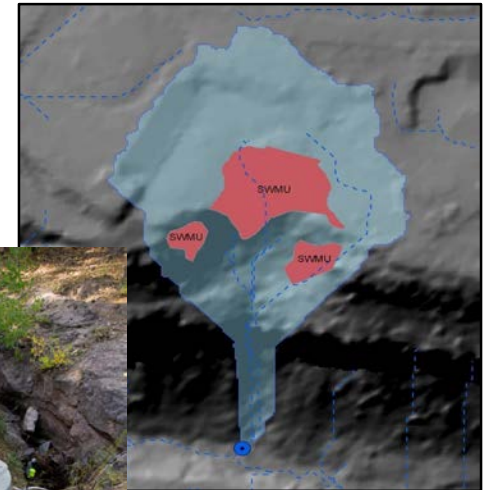


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# Update on Sampling Implementation Plan (SIP) Process

- Original idea came from stakeholders during 2014 permit renewal negotiations
- NMED 401 State Certification Condition
  - Annual sample plan
  - Monitoring requirements identified
  - Confirmation of representative sampling locations
- Began implementation in 2016
  - Completed spring 2018
  - Participation of NMED, DOE, N3B,
  - Detail reviews of surface water and sediment data at more than 250 Sites
  - About 30 percent of sites have no soil data
  - Site tours conducted at 250 site monitoring areas
- Results
  - 46 sampler moves planned (10%)
  - Agreement reached on all representative locations
  - Additional controls recommended at 23 locations
  - Additional 30 characterization sample locations recommended





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## Path Forward

- Complete monitoring requirements (constituent list) once IP is issued
- Develop first Sampling Implementation Plan – TBD
- Implement new sampling plan - TBD
